WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Plattsburgh (herein called "Town Board" and "Town", respectively), in the County of Clinton, New York, requested Laberge Group, Inc., a competent engineering firm duly licensed by the State of New York (herein called "Engineer") to prepare a preliminary map, plan and report for the construction and acquisition of water facilities, known as the Moffitt Road Waterline Extension at an estimated cost of \$1,000,000 in and for the Town of Plattsburgh Consolidated Water District (the "Water District"), and including all necessary materials, equipment, machinery and apparatus, land and rights-in-land required in connection therewith, and pursuant to the direction of the Town Board, the Engineer completed and filed with the Town Board such preliminary map, plan and report and following the report, the Engineer has determined that the estimated maximum costs of the Moffitt Road Waterline Extension are to be \$1,100,000.

WHEREAS, the additional costs of the construction and acquisition of said facilities in and for the Water District in the approximate amount of \$100,000 is anticipated to be financed on a long-term basis with zero percent or very low percent interest rate loans, if available, provided by the New York Environmental Facilities Corporation or other governmental funding source, and during the period of construction and acquisition with bond anticipation notes authorized by the Town Board and issued by the Town; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 202-b(5) of the Town Law, permission of the State Comptroller for the Town to undertake such construction and acquisition will not be required; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board wishes to review all environmental compliance requirements under Article 8 of the Environmental Conservation Law and the regulations promulgated there under from time to time with respect to the construction and acquisition of such Water District, and the environmental compliance file in this matter in and for the Water District is maintained and on file and available for public inspection at regular business hours, at the Town Hall offices; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board wishes to resolve its official intent to finance the additional costs of the construction and acquisition of water facilities, known as known as the Moffitt Road Waterline Extension at an estimated additional cost of \$100,000 in and for the Water District, on a tax-exempt basis for federal income tax purposes;

WHEREAS, the Town Board wishes to obtain the view of citizens, property owners principally residing outside the Town, governmental officials, public agencies and other interested persons in the subject thereof:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, that a meeting of the Town Board of the Town be held at the Town Hall, Plattsburgh, New York, on the January 12, 2009 at 6:45o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Time) to consider the construction, acquisition and financing of the additional costs of water facilities, known as the Moffitt Road Waterline Extension at an estimated cost of \$100,000 in and for the Water District, and ancillary facilities in connection therewith, and to hear all persons interested in the subject thereof concerning the same and for such other action on the part of the Town Board with relation thereto as may be required by law; and be it

FURTHER ORDERED, each project enumerated with a cost proposal attached thereto shall be treated as a separate item for which a hearing is held pursuant to section 202-b of the Town Law, and that the consolidation of notices for each such enumerated project is for administrative efficiency with full regard to the due notice and disclosure of the matters at hand to all interested persons; and be it

FURTHER ORDERED, that the Town Clerk publish at least once in the "PLATTSBURGH PRESS REPUBLICAN," a newspaper published in Plattsburgh, New York, and hereby designated as the official newspaper of the Town for such publication, and post on the sign board of the Town maintained pursuant to subdivision 6 of Section 30 of the Town Law, a copy of this Order, certified by said Town Clerk, the publication thereof and said posting to be not less than ten (10) nor more than twenty (20) days before the date of such public hearing; and be it
