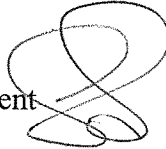

**RE: Water & Wastewater January Report**

- Collected all required monthly samples, including PFOA/1,4-Dioxane for Greater Plattsburgh and Cadyville Water Districts
- Meters read, and inventoried. Skip reports completed.
- Operation Reports to CCDH.
- Reviews of the monthly Planning Board Meeting regarding upcoming projects.
- 80 daily job orders. 43 locates for DSNY including 5 Emergency.
- Adjusted to Town related COVID-19 positive results and subsequent staffing issues.
- Two (2) operators participated in online training.
- There were 7 after hours call outs. We responded to an alarm at Sorrell Lift Station. A pump had tripped out after the wet well had pumped dry. There was a call out for 7 Adams Drive for a residential leak. The chlorine injection pump at GPWTP had to be replaced from one in inventory. There was a call out to 1332 Military Turnpike for a leak underneath the residence. We were contacted by Emergency Services for water coming up through the sidewalk in Morrisonville. It was determined this was a leak on the homeowners side of the shut off. They contacted a contractor and repairs were made to the service. We were called to 35 Romeo Circle to turn the water off due to a leak underneath the home. They called the next day after repairs had been made to turn the water back on.
- Repaired MLV box on Deer Run.
- Clean manholes and the digester at CWWTP.
- Troubleshooting the fire pump at Cadyville Booster Station on Church Street.
- Cleaned I-87 and Sorrell Ave wet wells.
- Replaced the meter registers and insulated the plumbing at the Harney Bridge Meter Vault.
- Pull and clean pump at Tom Miller Road Lift Station and replace the guide rails.
- In house sanitizing, and vehicle and equipment maintenance and repairs.
- Plowing and shoveling of plants and hydrants.
