- Maximum of 10 tires per vehicle
- Tires must be:
 - o Whole tires, No Rims, No excessive dirt, mud or water
 - o ONLY Passenger car or Passenger Truck (no semi, heavy truck, tractor, ATV, etc.)
 - o Must be less than 19.5"
