New York Road Green Infrastructure Project

WHEREAS, the Town of Plattsburgh has a current and active 2-year term contract with Laberge Group located at 4 Computer Drive West Albany, New York 12205; and

WHEREAS, Laberge Group is qualified to prepare maps, plans, surveys, investigations, environmental reviews, final designs, bid documents and conduct construction observation as necessary to complete the reconstruction of New York Road; and

WHEREAS, Part 617 of the Environmental Conservation Law - "State Environmental Quality Review Act" (SEQRA), provides for the review of any "ACTION" to determine the effect of the action on the environment, along with any related administrative procedures for the implementation, authorization or approval of the action; now therefore be it
